It is official! We are now united as “one church.” Last Sunday, both Narrow Trail Cowboy Church and Southfork Country Church voted overwhelming to come together as one church... hereafter to be called: “***Narrow Trail Cowboy Church.***”

This “union” of two church families is such a blessing from God! At the same time, please note that we have a lot to do to complete the unification process over the days, weeks, and even months ahead. So please bear with us for a short time while we work to incorporate the best “routine” processes of both churches in the weeks ahead, including re-constructing of our ON-LINE presence, such as “Live-Streaming” of our Sunday services, and consolidation of our websites into the Narrow Trail Cowboy Church website. For the immediate weeks ahead, we will be “Live-Streaming” just the second service at 10:45 AM.

Perhaps the most significant change will be that **starting this Sunday, March 17, 2024**, we will be having **TWO** services each Sunday. The early service will begin at 9:00 AM and conclude by 10:00 AM. The early service will feature the existing NTCC Band. The second service will begin at 10:45 AM and conclude by 11:45 AM, and the music service will be the existing SFCC band, which shall hereafter also be referred to as the “NTCC Band.”

The *most important* part of all of this is that in the weeks and months ahead, we will become a totally united church in all we do for the glory of Jesus!

It is our total belief that GOD has brought forth this glorious union. The “opportunities” ahead to: 1) Reach the “lost”; 2) Grow our ministries to our precious church family for fellowship, and learning more about God’s Word and how it applies to our daily lives.

Yet we know that when God is leading us in his infinite wisdom, it won’t be very long until it all becomes natural and blessed by Him! Please be praying for me (and all the other leaders in the church teams) that God will provide us the “path” for this glorious new future!
